Key Verses: Act 1:4,8 KJV - 4 ...[He] commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father... - 8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me...

1. Repentance leads to refreshing.

Act 2:38 KJV - 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive **the gift of the Holy Ghost.**

Act 3:19 KJV - 19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Act 2:2 KJV - 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

3. The ministry of the Holy Spirit will glorify Jesus.

Jhn 16:14 KJV - 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew [it] unto you.
